Budget Hearings

Page 2- BLRC - June 29, 2022

Annual Budget

Mitch Poulsen presented and reviewed the fiscal year 2023 budget. Idaho has committed to support the Regional Commission with one hundred thousand dollars for the upcoming year, we expect Utah to step up and match that amount.

Rich County and Bear Lake County will each contribute thirty thousand.

\$10,000-dollars for administrating the Economic Development Grant from Rich County.

The Idaho Aquatic Invasive Species program will contribute \$60,000. Most of this is passthrough money going to the Utah program for Invasive species with a small percentage for administrative fees going to the Regional Commission.

Expenses were reviewed with salary increases and a wage adjustment to come closer to market values reflected in the salary's category.

There was discussion of the budget funding and expenses, and discussion of salary increases.

• Albert Johnson made a motion to accept the 2023 budget as presented Ken Brown seconded the motion, motion carried, with Commissioner Brad Jensen abstaining from the vote.

Amended Budget for 2022

Postage and Office supplies were amended to reflect actual costs. These were small enough changes that a public hearing was not required.
